# Jesus Walks on the Water

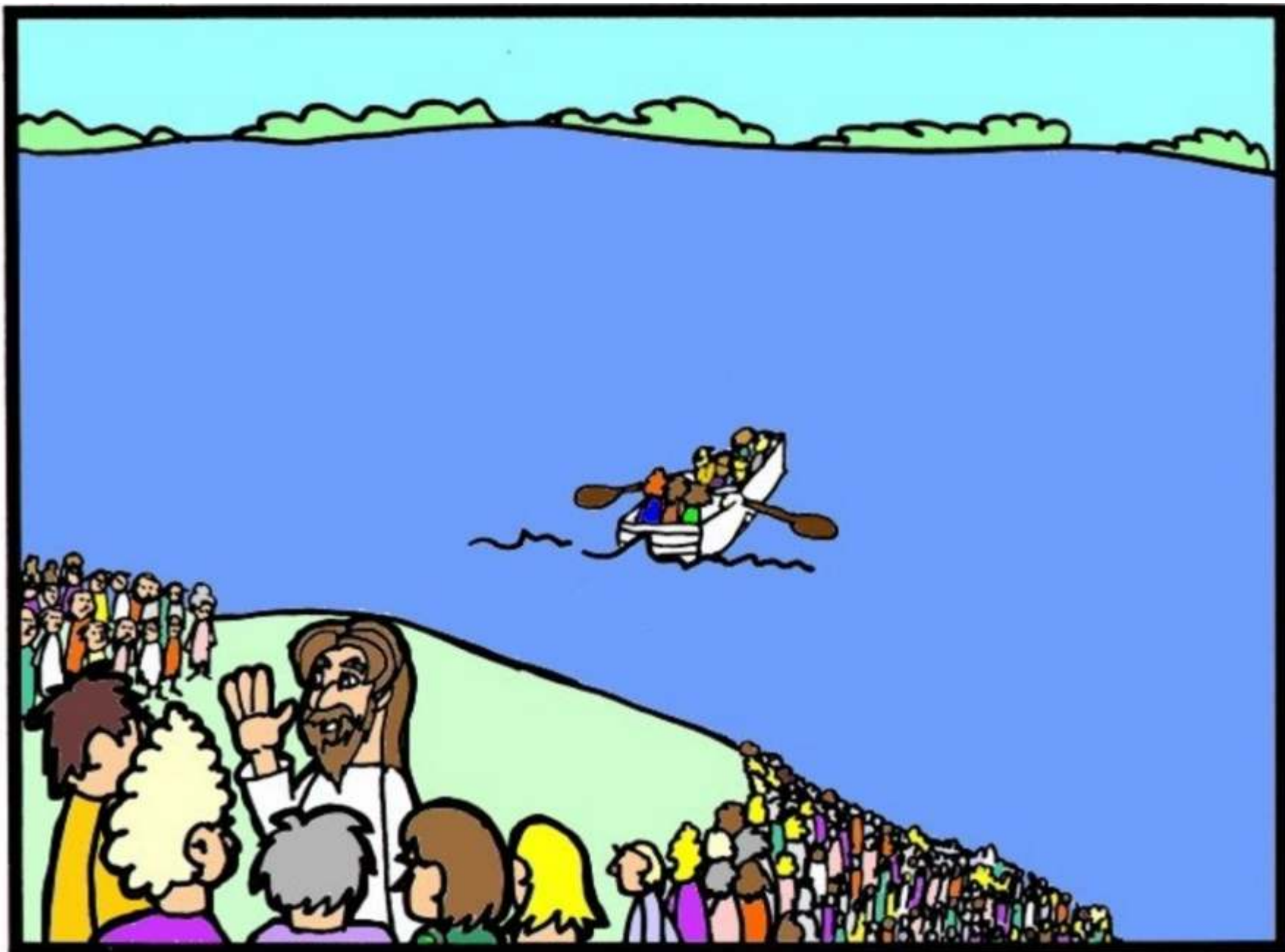

Then he climbed up on a mountain, by himself and he prayed.



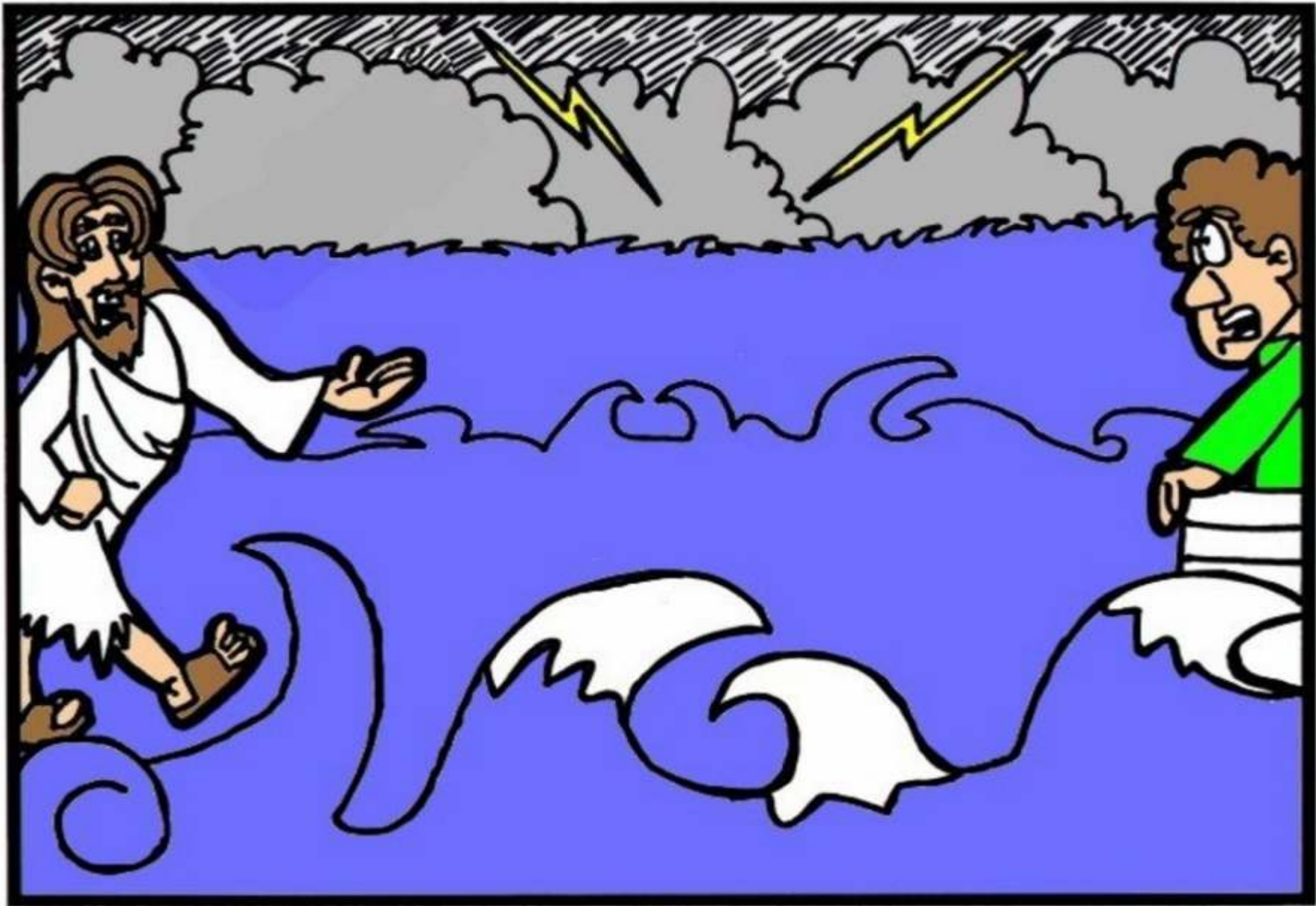

Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water to go to Jesus.





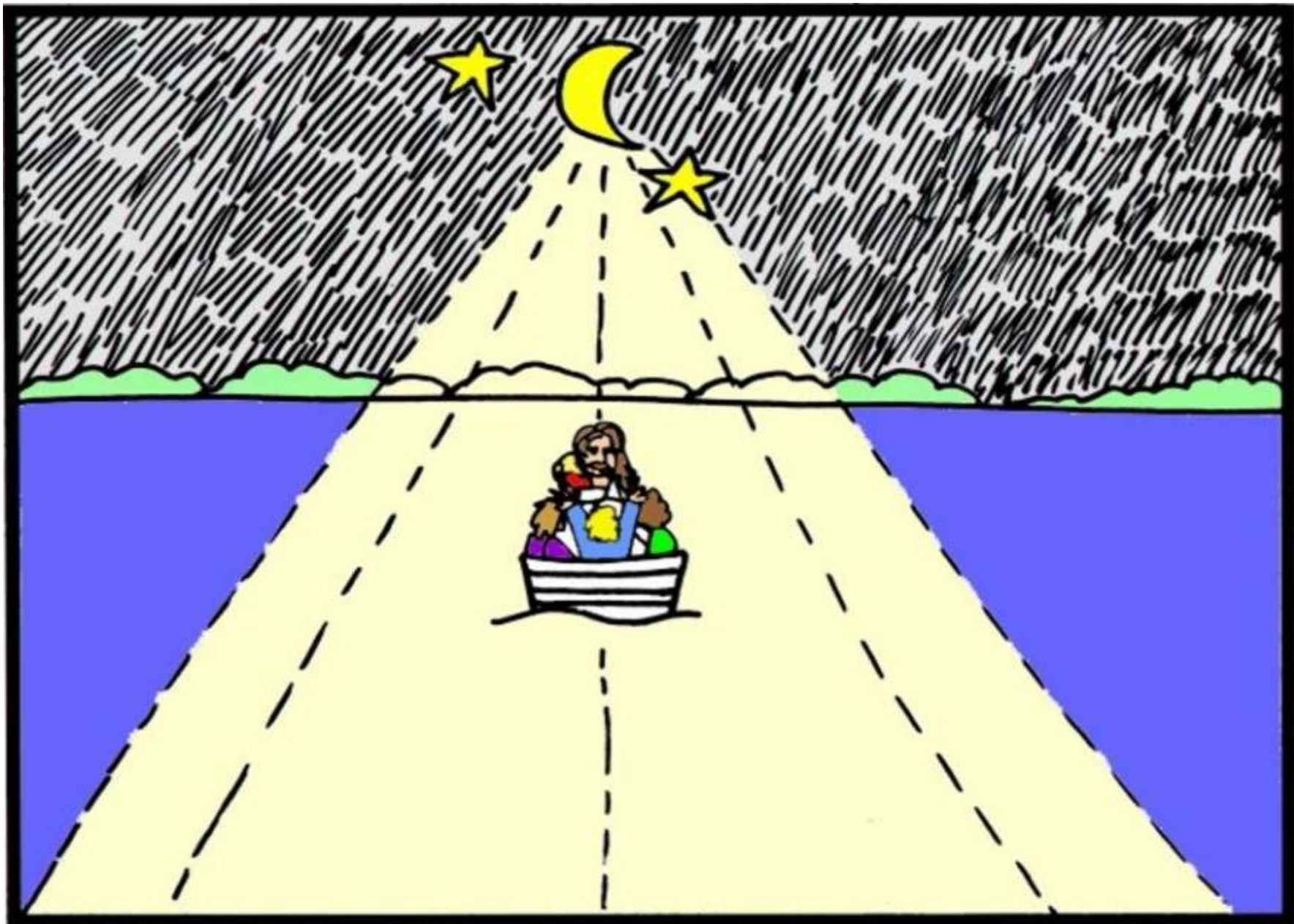
