The Prodigal Son

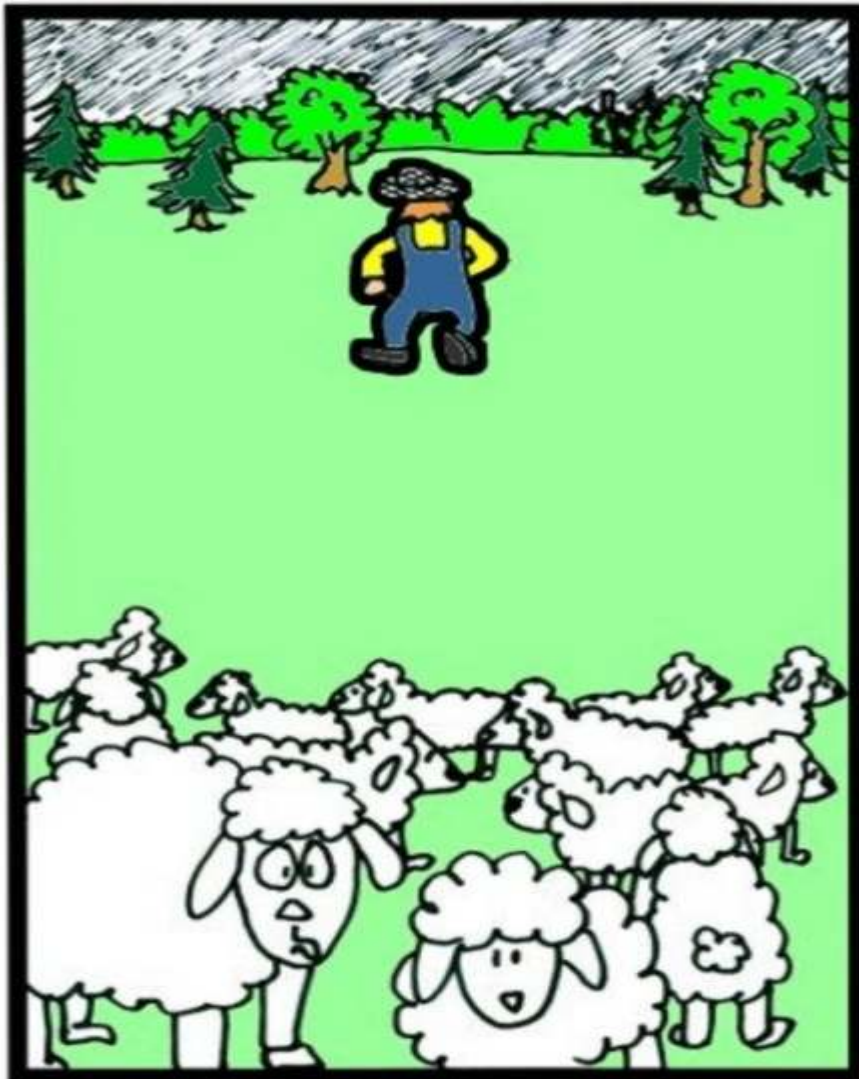

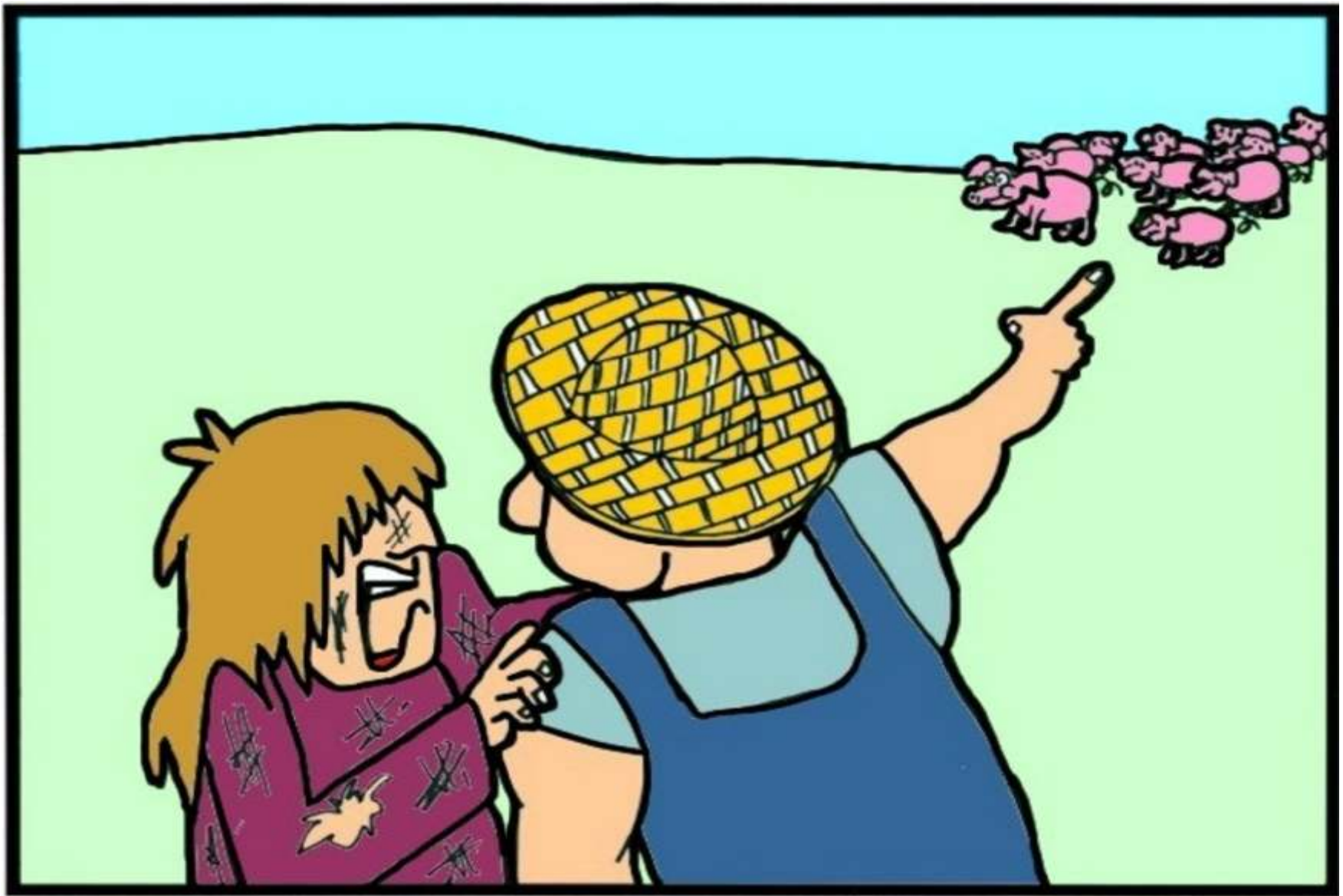

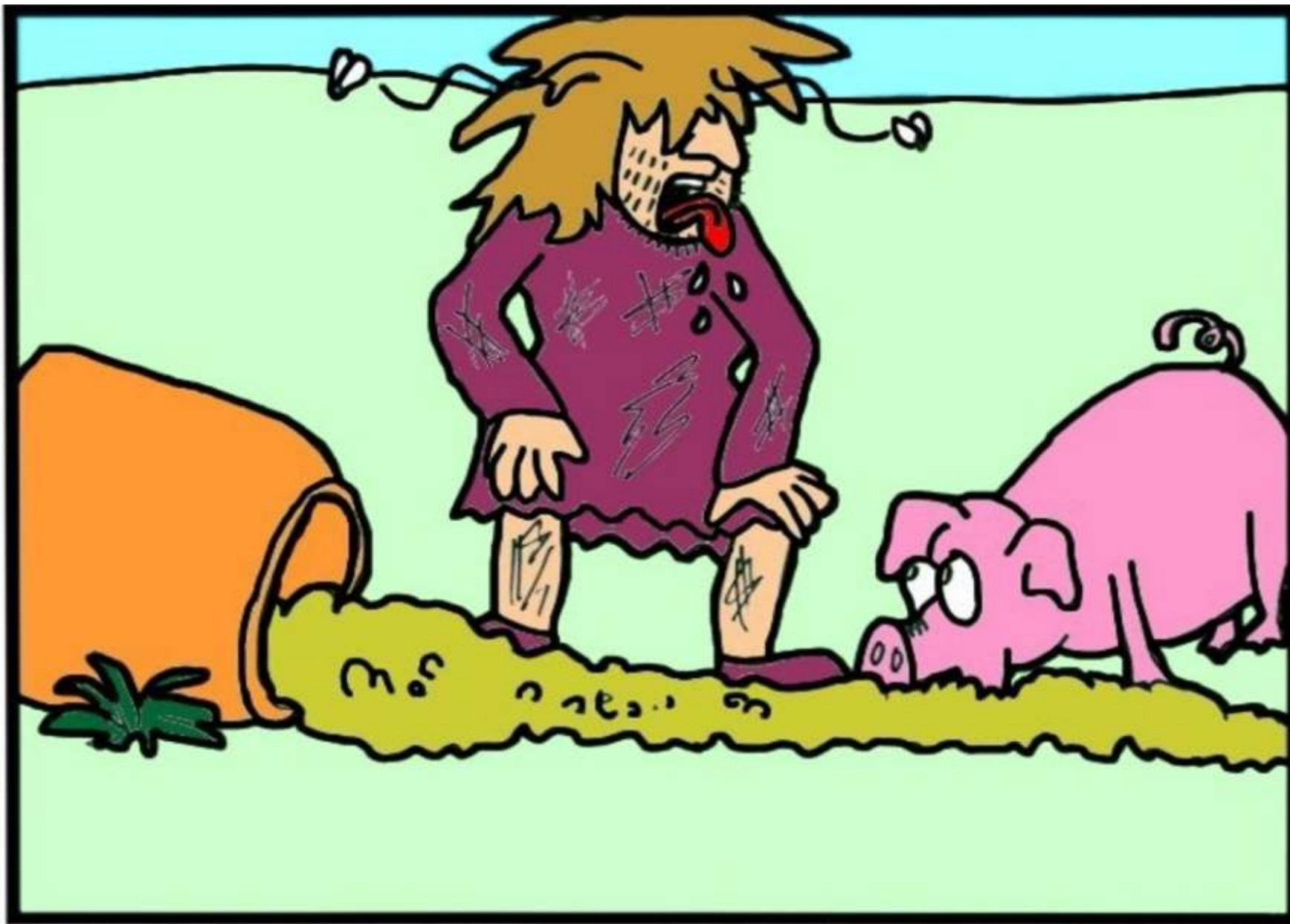
