# Triumphal Entry of Jesus

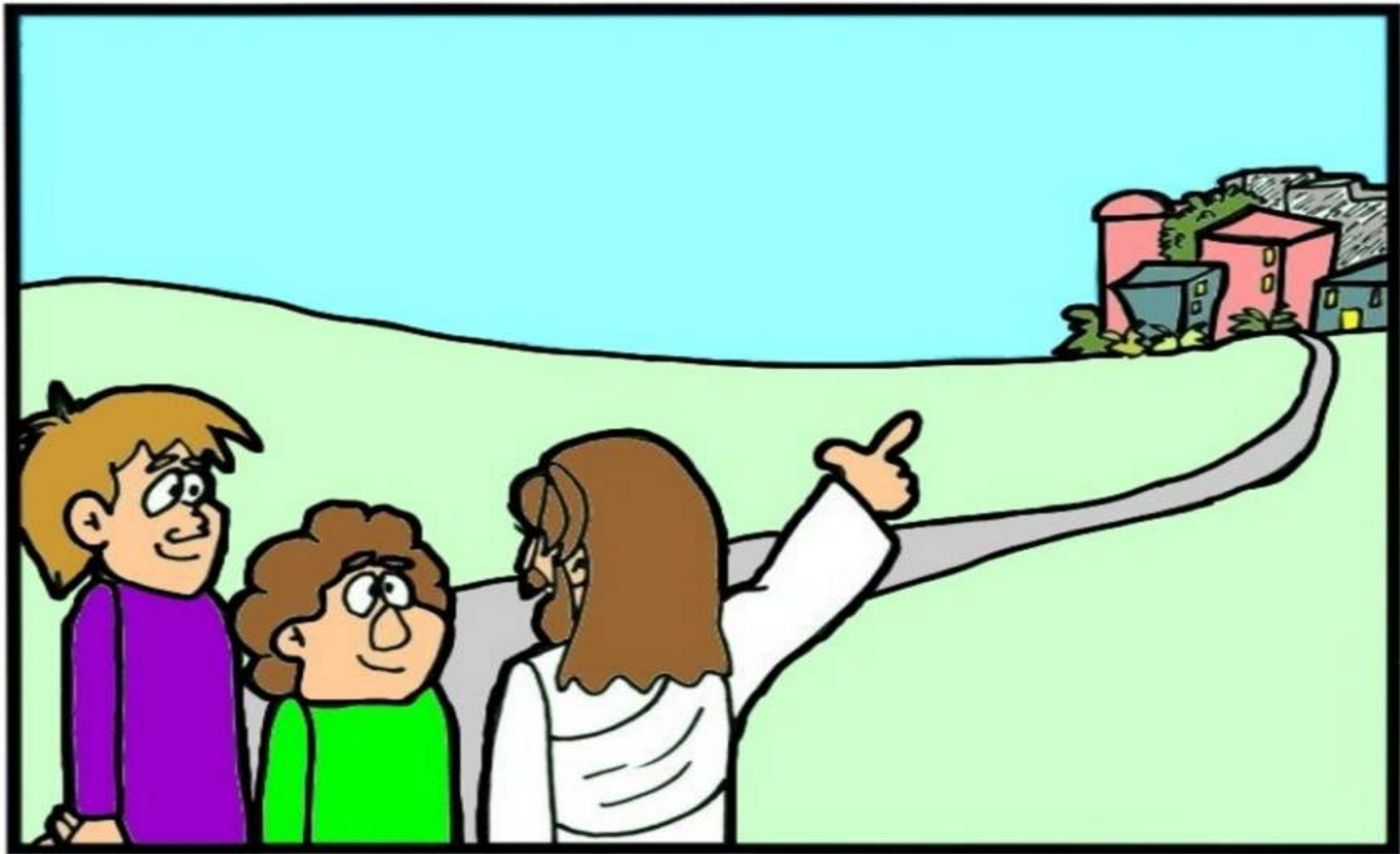

The disciples put their clothes onto the donkey's back and Jesus sat on the little donkey.



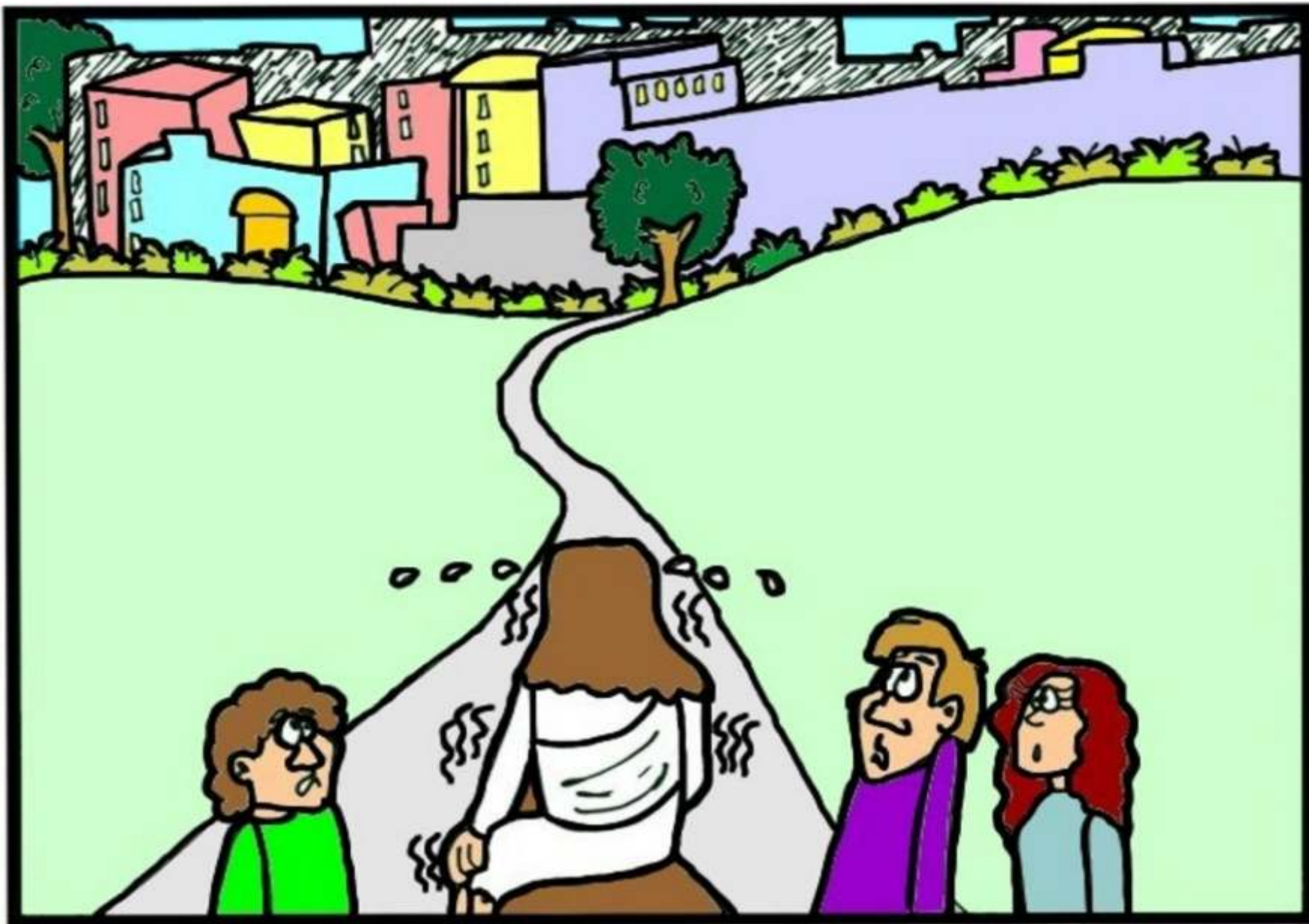

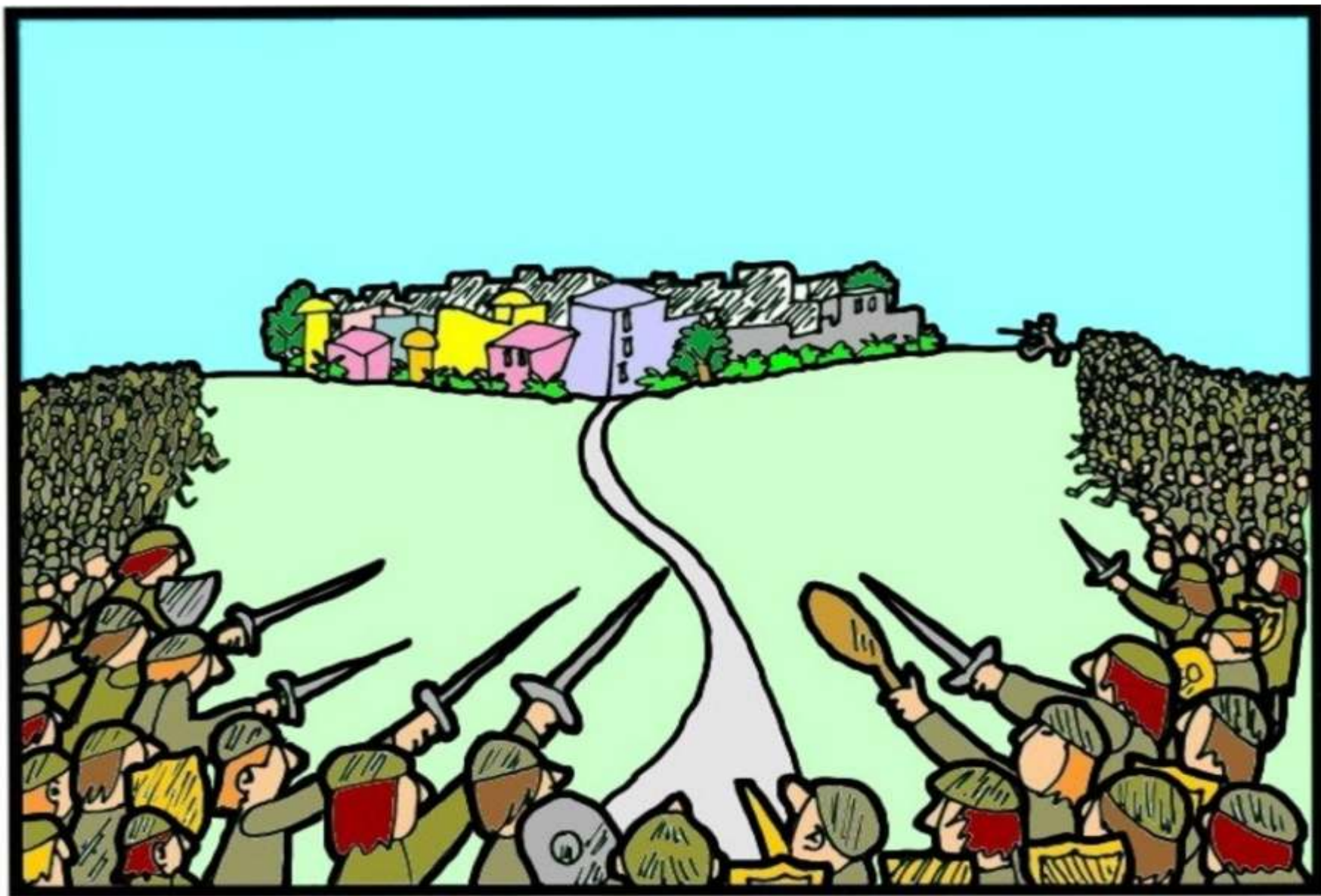
"Tell your followers to shut up!" said the phony Pharisees. Jesus answered, "If these people shut up the stones will start shouting."
